You will be posting these opportunities in Bryant Career Connection (BCC), powered by Handshake. BCC is the University's job board system and once you create an account, you will also be able to post internship and full-time opportunities. Below are instructions to help you get started.

Instructions

If you already have a Handshake account, simply [log in](#) and select Bryant University to request permission to post.

If your company or HR department/person already has a Handshake account, please contact them to post/get permission to post.

- To help expedite the approval process, please email Scott Connolly, (sconnolly@bryant.edu) and let him know you are interested in posting as part of the Summer Jobs Project

If you/your company do not have a Handshake account, click [here](#) to easily create an account.

- Although a company email is preferred, you can use a personal email.
- You will be asked to fill out some basic information including a webpage.
 - A link to a Facebook page, yellow pages, or Yelp page will work as well, if your organization does not have a website.
- Once you create an account, please request to post opportunities at Bryant University.

- After you are approved, you can post all available opportunities to Bryant.
